Frank Hoffman, III was in a head on collision in Beaumont, Texas. He is the brother of Deidre Williams. He lives in Florida but was in Texas working. He sustained severe injuries to his lower body. He has been through two major surgeries to repair multiple fractures of the femur, pelvis and hip. He had to have two metal rods put in place to repair his femur; metal plates to repair his pelvis and has had to have his hip replaced.

The trauma surgeons did not expect him to survive the first few days. Frank has beaten those odds and has shown remarkable courage and strength through this devastating tragedy.
