The Paschal Candle

Today we will light the Paschal candle (a gift from the Asbury Class to our pastoral family to be used in worship) dated back to the fourth century and representing the Passover or Easter. In general it signifies Christ as the Light of the World." Ours in particular (because of the markings chosen by our pastor) signifies "Christ, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world. It is burned during Easter through ascension, and at baptism and funeral and other ties which are sacramental. Every time you see it burning think of the Lamb of God that takes away the sins of the world.
