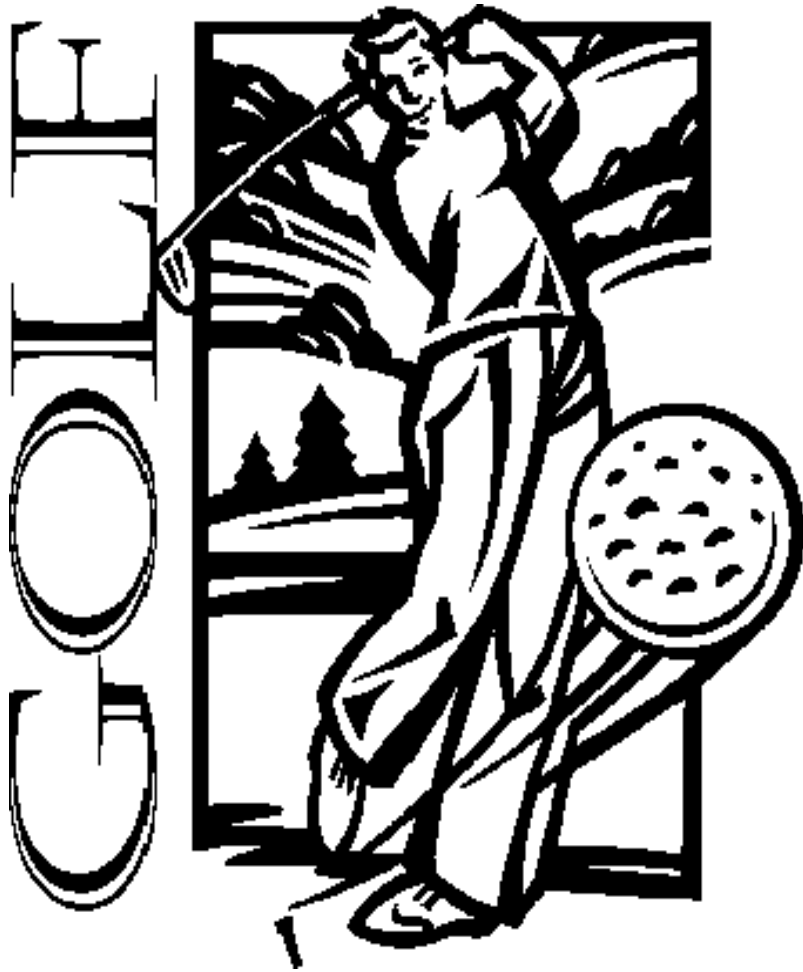

We will return Monday, August 10 at approximately 4:30 p.m. Youth will contact parents via cell phones as we approach town.

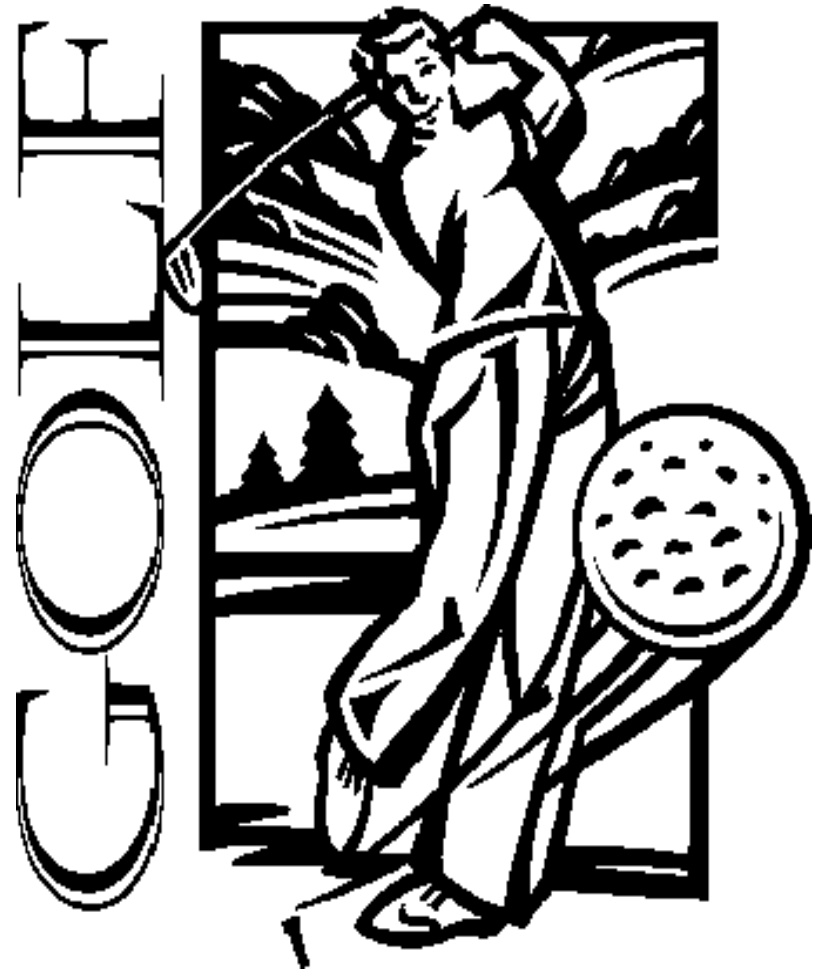
