The other night Sandy Waldron and I were answering an invitation from our bishop to gather at Main St. UMC in Kernersville to hear a presentation concerning the revitalization of the church in the WNCC. Dr. Steve James invited all our churches to become involved in the renewal of our church through prayer, gifts of service, and financial contributions.

Over the last few years I have been involved in several of these kinds of endeavors. Some worked well while others did not meet our expectations. The thought behind them was to offer prayer and financial support to churches which are failing and want to do better, and to renew the church through building new churches - new church plants. For the most part the church growth experts believe this is the way to grow the church.

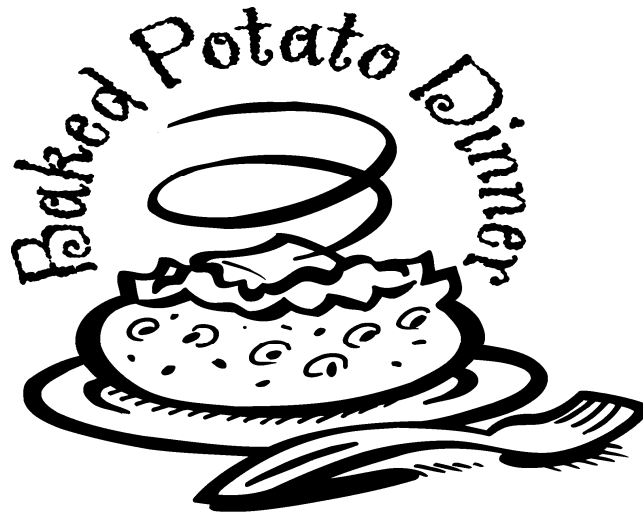
I have always supported this effort because I wanted to be a part of giving the church a chance to succeed rather than being a roadblock to unseen opportunities. I don't know if these efforts will work or fail. I do know that if nothing is done failure is certain.

With all that said allow me to explain how I intend to move forward with this project, knowing our financial situation, the ministries we want to carry forward, and allowing for us to participate in building the Kingdom through our conference. In the narthex I will place sheets of paper with spaces for your name and address. I want you to fill that out for your family. After we have done that for two or three weeks, I will copy them (gotta have a copy) and send the original to the Conference office. They will send you a letter asking for your support - prayerful and financial. They will be asking for support from \$50.00 to \$5,000.00. I am sure they will not refuse more, but let me suggest what I am doing and propose for each family to do. I plan to give \$50.00 as a one time gift and I am asking that you do the same. There will even be a card in your letter asking for the amount and explaining that you can pay it over several payments. This amount of gift from a large percent of our church allows us to participate in the bishop's program in a great way while not taking away from our current ministry projects or our own renewal efforts. We have over 250 family units in our family of faith. That means that if each family gave \$50 we, as a church, would give over \$12,000.00. I don't know about you but I think that is pretty good.

I want to thank you in advance for your participation and let you know that you are a Kingdom builder. I appreciate all that you do that allows the waters of the Kingdom rise.
